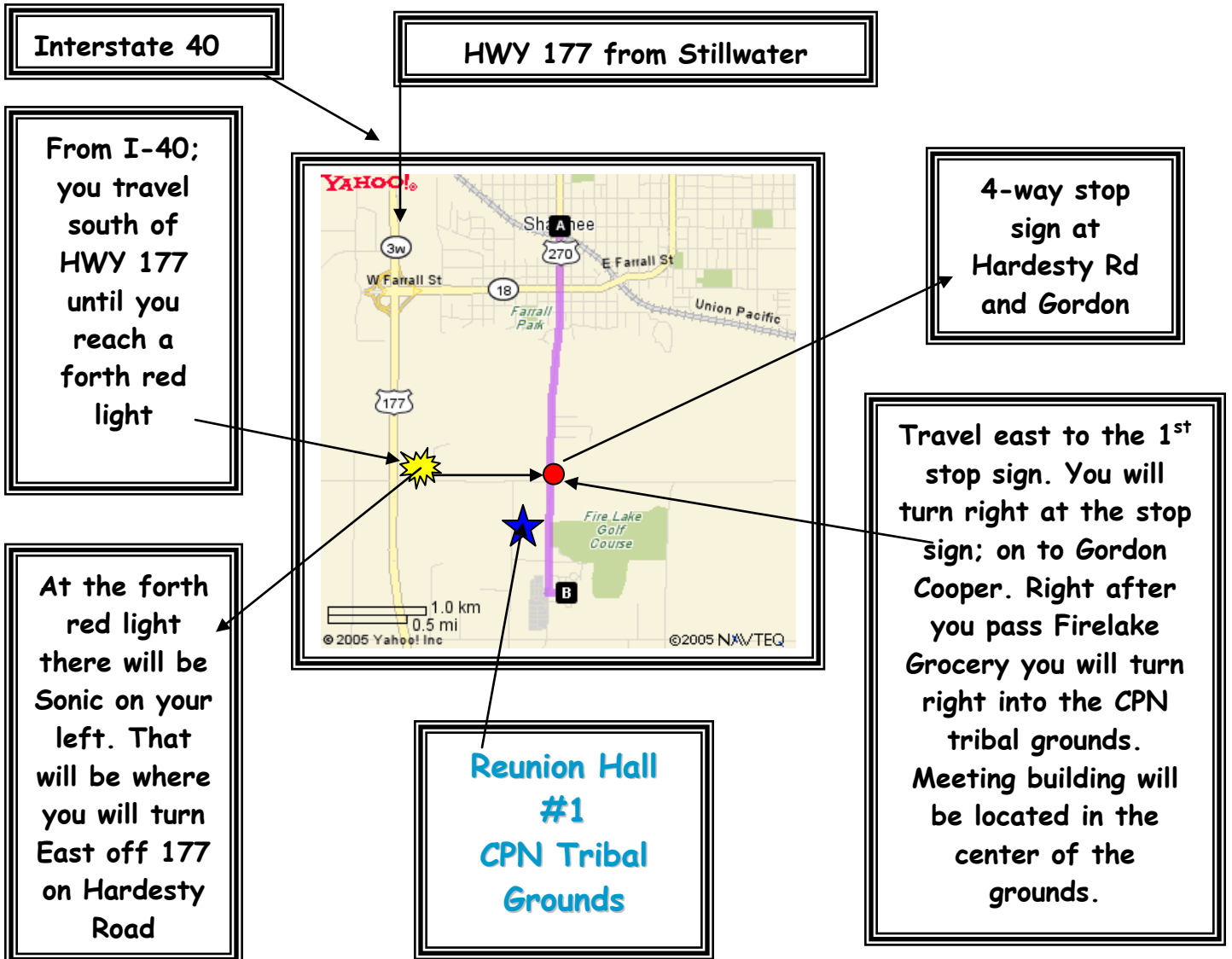

HWY 177 from Stillwater

From I-40; you travel south of HWY 177 until you reach a forth red light

4-way stop sign at Hardesty Rd and Gordon

At the forth red light there will be Sonic on your left. That will be where you will turn East off 177 on Hardesty Road

Travel east to the 1<sup>st</sup> stop sign. You will turn right at the stop sign; on to Gordon Cooper. Right after you pass Firelake Grocery you will turn right into the CPN tribal grounds. Meeting building will be located in the center of the grounds.
